The Significance of Connection

In September, we began a new worship series called "Connection" where we began exploring the beauty and significance of a live lived in community with God and others. In our first weekend of the series we reflected on these words from the Apostle John:



"That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched - this we proclaim concerning the Word of life...We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and

with his Son, Jesus Christ."
- 1 John 1:1, 3

John's words paint a beautiful and intimate picture of the kind of community we find in God's Church: fellowship (or koinonia in Greek) with one another and with the Father and Son through the power of the Holy Spirit. But John's words point us in the direction of another connection we are privileged to have, and that's the connection of our lives of faith to those of the original followers of Jesus.

John says, "That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched - this we proclaim concerning the Word of life." These words point us back to the experiences of the original disciples, Paul the Apostle, and people like James (the brother of Jesus!), Mary Magdalene, Joanna, and others who were not only witnesses to



Jesus' earthly ministry, but who spoke with, dined with, and touched the resurrected Christ after that first Easter Sunday. When I read John's words regarding what "our hands have touched" I also immediately think of Thomas putting his hands into the nail wounds on Jesus' own hands, confirming that not only was Jesus crucified, but he was also risen!

So, as we journey deeper into our Connection series, let's take a moment to appreciate how remarkable it is that through the faith of the Church and the testimony of the Scriptures we experience a very special connection with these first followers of Jesus. May we not take their words for granted, and may we believe as they believed.



an option and a decision parents can make whether to excuse their children or keep them in worship. Bible Activity Page handouts with crayons and Sermon Notes for Kids to use in worship are available in the Lobby.

SPLASH Kids Mask Update: Spry Church Council has decided as of September 12th the following policy will



be enacted: children and teachers of children are expected to wear masks inside any church building. We ask this in order to protect and care for

the most vumerable among us. Thank you for your patience, understanding, and faithfulness during these challenging days.

We will be taking every precaution to keep everyone safe and this is how:

- children and teachers will be wearing masks
- no drink no food
- each child has individual pencil boxes with crayons/ markers/colored pencils/glue stick
- high touch surfaces cleaned between services with cleaning solution and wipes
- if your child is not feeling well, please do not excuse them to go upstairs. This will help to maintain a healthy environment
- parents please remain in the hallway for your child in order to limit the amount of people in and out of the rooms.

Thank you for your support and understanding as we are excited to see your children and continue guiding and teaching them about Jesus!

Guppy Room Nursery: is open for all service times: We will strive to keep our most precious lil' ones safe by implementing a few guidelines. We ask parents after checking-in at the SPLASH Kids Check-In in the lobby; please bring your child to the Guppy Room door where nursery staff will take the child's temperature and sign in your child. We ask parents not to enter the room when dropping off and picking up limiting the amount of people in and out of the room. Our staff will at all times wear a mask and follow CDC recommendations for attending to infants and toddlers. Hand washing and the use of an alcohol-free hand sanitizer for toddler age will be used. Surfaces and toys will be cleaned between services with cleaning solutions and wipes. If your child is not feeling well, please do not bring them into the nursery. This will help to maintain a healthy environment.


'Then you will call on me and come pray to me and I will listen to you.' Jeremiah 29:12.
