SERMON TITLE: 2 KINGS

"All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

- 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Josiah was the last God-honoring king of Judah. When the young king, only 18 years old at the time, found the Book of the Law and read it, he was convicted of his sin and the sin of his people. He went to great lengths to repent. Josiah removed anything that had to do with worshipping false gods. He burned down temples, smashed altars, ground down idols to powder, scattered ashes to the wind. He did this so that no one would be tempted to return to worshipping false gods. He did this because he recognized that sin needed to be dealt with. He did this because he was convicted of his sin and wanted to honor God.

We too must recognize our sin, repent, turn from that sin and toward God. We need to get serious about getting rid of sin in our lives. Are we tempted by a particular sin? What can we do to remove any trace of temptation, any association, anything that might make us stumble? Its time to get serious about it!

Sometimes when you need to quit something, you have to get serious about it, you need to get rid of any trace of it, to avoid the temptation to go back to it.
