


As part of our transition planning and strategy, Suffolk Christian Church engaged The Center for Healthy churches and the assistance of Rev. Dr. Tracy Hartman as our Intentional Interim Pastor to lead us in a series of Congregational Conversations.

The primary goals of these conversations were to identify


Our pastor will guide and walk alongside us, providing leadership in the following four areas:

#### Preaching and Worship:

- Work with the staff to prepare for and lead worship services
- Prepare and deliver sermons weekly
- Officiate weddings, funerals and other special services as needed
- Administer the sacraments of the Lord's Supper and Baptism
- Work with deacons to provide pulpit supply when the pastor is away

#### **Pastoral Care**

- Work with the Deacon Body to support the spiritual, emotional and physical well-being of individual church members
- Provide pastoral counseling to church members
- Respond pastorally and appropriately to persons experiencing a crisis and in need
- Oversee hospital and in-home visitation (critical care visitation or first response visitation) which may include visitation training for staff and church members



#### **Leadership Development**

- Work with the appropriate governing boards to encourage and guide the church staff
- Coordinate the work of the staff and the overall flow of the office
- Work with the appropriate boards on hiring decisions for church staff positions
- Seek to engage and empower church members to serve in all aspects of church life
- Report to the church at regular and special call business meetings, as well as participate in meetings of various boards and committees as needed or requested

#### Mission and Vision

- Help the church live into her vision and provide leadership for the church's overall mission
- Be available as a resource for church leadership teams, groups and ministries in fulfilling the mission of the church
- Represent the church in our community

- A thorough understanding of the Bible, with the ability to interpret, clarify, explain, and apply scripture in preaching and teaching
- Seminary educated and trained, having earned a Master of Divinity or higher degree from an accredited seminary or its equivalent
