The AALC Women of L.I.F.E. Bible Study for 2021 is entitled *Beloved Apprentice: Becoming a House of Prayer* written by Sue DeSha of Christ Lutheran Church in Duluth, Minnesota. The monthly study is a word and prayer workshop for women who want to grow in their relationship with God and with each other in a small group setting. One special feature of the study is its flexibility. If you don’t complete a lesson together, it can easily be finished at home as a personal devotional.
