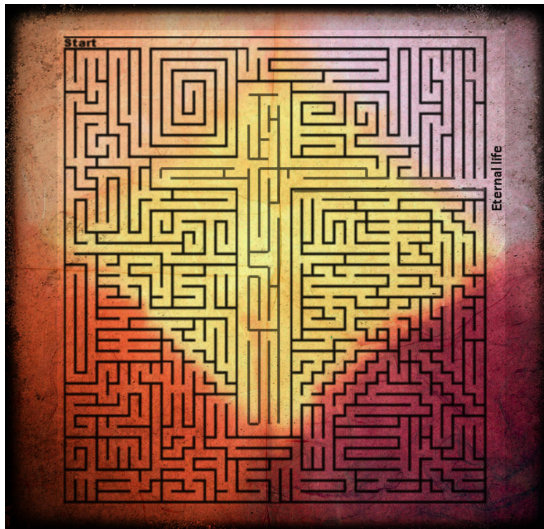


## Life Group Discussion Guide



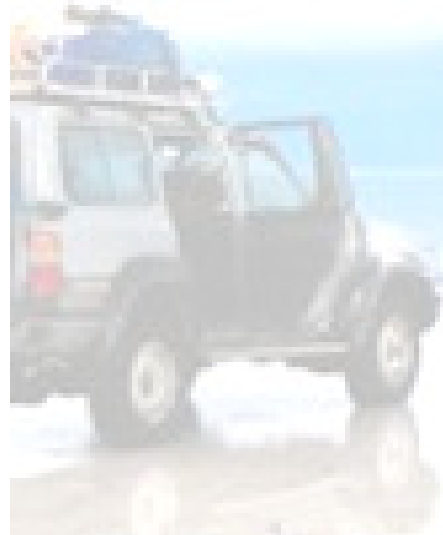
1. What mistake did the expert in the Law make? Luke 10:25-29.

4. What is the purpose for the Law? Romans 3:19-20. Have you seen yourself in the Ten Commandments? How many have you kept? Should the Ten Commandments be used in evangelism?
5. What did Christ do to take us out of the pit? Isaiah 53
