

I. *Jesus Commands* us to trust him as we trust God the Father (v.1)

"Trust in God also Trust in Me." Jesus makes himself equal to God the Father.

Application/Implication: We show trust in Jesus by not being characterized by fear.

II. *Jesus Comes* again to take us to himself and God the Father (vv.2-4)

Jesus reassures his disciples that he will not abandon, but bring them to himself.

Application/Implication: We should hold loosely to this world.

III. *Jesus Claims* to be the only way to get to God the Father (vv.5-7)

Jesus is the way to God, because he is the truth of God and the life of God.

Application/Implication: Let's confess Jesus with our mouths and believe in our hearts.
