

1. God's Voice is Sufficient because it reveals to us His Son perfectly, and He is more than enough, Hebrews 1-13; 1:1-4; John 14-16; 2 Timothy 3:14-17; Isaiah 8:19-20; Jeremiah 23:29.

2. God's voice is understandable; it is clear, Deuteronomy 30:11-14.
 - A. Some parts of Scripture are clearer than others, 2 Peter 3:16.
 - B. The central themes are abundantly clear and repeated, 1 Corinthians 15:1-6; 2 Corinthians 1:13; 2 Peter 1:12-21.
 - C. This is not rocket science, or brain surgery. With careful study and care you can understand what God means in the Bible, Nehemiah 8; 2 Timothy 3:15.
 - D. You may not understand the Bible perfectly, but you can understand it sufficiently.
