The Experience of God who is...

1. Unrelenting; what He says, He will do; He always keeps His commitments, 1 Kings 8:15; 2 Samuel 7; 1 Chronicles 29; Isaiah 14:24; Jeremiah 1:12; Romans 8:32; 1 Corinthians 15:10; 2 Corinthians 1:20; 9:8; 1 Peter 1:13.

2. Unrelenting, no one like Him, 1 Kings 8:23; Isaiah 40-66; Jeremiah 9:23-24; Exodus 20:4-6; Galatians 6:14.

3. Uncontainable, 1 Kings 8:27; Acts 17:22-31.

4. Immanently worthy of power, and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise, 1 Kings 8:16-20; 1 Chronicles 29:10-22; Daniel 7:13-14; Ephesians 1:6, 12, 14; Revelation 4-5; Philippians 2:9-11.
