

DRESS CODE AND PERSONAL ITEMS

Children should wear shoes and clothing appropriate to the season. Clothing should be clean, easy to manage, the correct size and should not display any non-Christ honoring apparel. All items should be clearly labeled with the child's name.

Students can wear:

Pants, jeans, capris

Shorts or skorts (cannot be 2" above the knee when standing)

Athletic wear

T-shirts, collared shirts or blouses

Tennis shoes, sandals with straps around the ankle

Students cannot wear:

Bandanas or hats in the building

Extreme hairstyles and colors

Short-shorts or bare stomachs

Open back shoes, Crocs, or Heelys

Tight or overly baggy clothing

Tank tops or tops with spaghetti straps

No flip flops (except swim days)

Swimsuits/Sunscreen

One piece swimsuits are required. Tankini-style suits are allowed if they cover the student's stomach. Sunscreen should be worn, if you choose during summer time, but must be applied prior to coming to school.

Camp T-shirts

Camp T-shirts must be worn on field trip days for security and safety.

Toys and Other Personal Items

All personal belongings and toys should be left at home. The Academy will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or broken items. All electronic devices (i.e. cell phone, electronic games, and music players) are not allowed at our facility.
