Chicken Soup

2 Tbsp Vegetable oil
1 Medium onion, chopped
5 Cloves garlic, smashed
2" piece of fresh ginger sliced
1 small cauliflower cut into florets (or Rice cauliflower)
3/4 tsp. crushed red pepper flakes
1 medium carrot, thinly sliced on a bias
6 cups low sodium chicken broth
1 stalk of celery, thinly sliced
2 boneless, skinless chicken breast
Fresh chopped parsley for garnish

Warm your tummy up...

- *In a large pot over medium heat, heat oil and add onion, garlic and ginger, cook until beginning to brown
- *Meanwhile pulse cauliflower, then add to pot and cook until it begins to brown for about 8 min.
- *Add pepper flakes, carrots, celery and chicken broth and bring to a simmer. Add chicken, continue to cook.
- *Remove chicken from the pot and shred, meanwhile continue cooking veggies in pot.
- *Add shredded chicken back into your soup mixture. Remove piece of ginger from pot. Continue to cook until veggies are tender. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Garnish with fresh parsley before serving.



Sick Policy

When a child exhibits signs of illness, a determination will be made by the Director regarding the discharge of the child to a parent. If the child is to be dismissed, the child will immediately be isolated from the other children. The parent or guardian will be notified to **pick the child up within 40 minutes**. In cases in which the parent cannot be reached, emergency contacts will be called. When the child is picked up, the parent or emergency contact will receive a yellow illness report to sign that will state the date when the child is available to return to the Preschool according to management of communicable disease guidelines.
