Dr. Dobson Speaks Hope Amidst the Panic

I am writing to you this month to express compassion and hope to those among my readers who are deeply troubled today by the uncertainty of our times. While our nation and our world have reason to be concerned by the coronavirus that stalks the human family, we must also exercise sound judgment and shine the light of hope. I don't intend to heighten your apprehension, but want to point all of us to the Great Physician who told us we should "Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7). It is comforting to know that the Creator of the universe is mindful of our circumstances and invites us to call on Him in these distressing times.

My wife, Shirley, wrote a book entitled, "*Certain Peace in Uncertain Times*," which speaks to our fears and anxieties. She shared, "We all want peaceful lives and contented hearts. Yet, with threats to our tranquility growing at a seemingly exponential rate, is it any wonder that many of us succumb to worry and fear? More important, is there a solution? Can we know certain peace in these uncertain times? The answer, of course, is yes. . . 1 When problems threaten to engulf us, we must do what believers have always done—turn to the Lord for encouragement and solace."2

Look What's cooking...

3 Ingredient Biscuits

Biscuit making doesn't get any simpler than these 3-Ingredient biscuits. Slather them with butter...

- 2 cups self-rising flour, (White Lily is best)
- 1/4 cup vegetable shortening OR butter
- 3/4 cup buttermilk
- Melted butter, (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 450 degrees. Lightly grease a rimmed baking sheet or a cast iron pan with shortening or butter. Or you can line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

Place flour in a large bowl. Add shortening or butter and cut it in with a pastry blender or 2 forks or 2 knives. You don't want any pieces bigger than a small pea. (Note: using butter instead of shortening makes taller golden biscuits)

Slowly pour buttermilk in, stirring gently as you pour. Keep gently stirring until flour is moistened but do not overmix.


Transfer dough to a lightly floured piece of parchment paper. Gently pat it out until it is 1/2-inch thickness.

Cut out biscuits using a 2-inch floured biscuit cutter, Do not twist the cutter as you press it down. Just use a straight up and down motion. Press together the scraps and cut one more biscuit.

Place biscuits so they are just barely touching each other on the baking sheet.

Bake for 10 to 12 minutes. Brush with melted butter and serve.
