## **Connect Groups - Sermon Review Questions**

For the week of 2/18/24

Scripture Passage: Mark 16:1-7
Sermon Title: "Getting Back to Where You Started"

1. Icebreaker: What's the most embarrassing fashion trend that you can remember? Were you a participant or a spectator to this trend?
2. Pastor Rob opened with the concept of asking where certain disciples wer in the aftermath of the crucifixion of Jesus. Tell about a time when you went through something challenging and wondered where certain people were

during your time of need. Explain your answer.

3. In the example of Peter denying Jesus, Pastor Rob said to "always keep your heart prepared for rejection." Explain how you have come to understand this principle to be true in your life.

4. Has there been a time when you felt like a complete failure (like Peter felt) but God "called you by name" and you experienced His grace to continue? Give a personal example and explain what you learned in the process.
5. Read Mark 16:6-7. What can we learn from the example of how Peter was treated post-failure in our relationships as we encounter people who need to experience grace and forgiveness?
6. What is one course of action that you can take this week as a result of something from the sermon?
7. What observation from this week's sermon did you personally find to be most impactful?
