

How do I share the gift of God?

1. **Share my testimony:** *"Come and hear, all you who fear God, and I will tell what he has done for my soul"* (Psalm 66:16).
 - a. My life before Christ
 - b. How I received Christ
 - c. My life after Christ
2. **Share the Gospel in my testimony:** *"For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek"* (Romans 1:16).
 - a. Sin separated me from God: *"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"* (Romans 3:23; 6:23a).
 - b. Payment for my sin is death: *"For the wages of sin is death"* (Romans 6:23).
 - c. Jesus died for the payment of my sin: *"But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us"* (Romans 5:8).
 - d. Trusted Jesus as my Lord and believed in His resurrection: *"Because if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved"* (Romans 10:9).
 - e. Now I have relationship of peace with God: *"Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ"* (Romans 5:1).
3. **Encourage the reading of God's Word,** starting with a chapter a day from the *Gospel of John*: *"It is no longer because of what you said that we believe, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is indeed the Savior of the world"* (John 4:42).
