- 3. Meditate on the power displayed by God at the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. How might focusing on this glorious truth shape your prayers?
- 4. What does Paul mean in Eph 3:16-17 when he prays that God would give folks strong power through his Spirit in our inner being?
- a. What is the purpose for this spiritual power?
- b. Compare and contrast how this power works with the power mentioned in vss 17-19.
- 5. Discuss these two questions from the author:
- a. What grounds or reasons lurk behind your prayers? How can you improve on these?
- b. What steps can you take to make the glory of God the central concern of your life?
