

PSALM 119

Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible. There are 22 stanzas, and each stanza is made up of eight verses that start with the same letter from the Hebrew alphabet.

The Psalm continuously refers to the Word of God and the lifeline it is in our lives. As you read the Psalm throughout the week, recognize (or even better underline) every mention of God's Word, reflect on these questions, and pray.

Reflections Questions (same for each day): What does this say about God?
What is the purpose of the Word? How does the Word shape your life today?
What command(s) is given?
