We are all adventuring through uncharted territory and can find strength in God's gift of community to carry us through this time.

We have also cancelled all upcoming events through at least April 13th: that includes Covenant Partnership Class, Women's Retreat, and 21 Days of Community. We will continue to assess and follow CDC and public health officials recommendations.

If you are feeling lost, discouraged, or scared, please don't go through that alone! Be vulnerable and invite others to walk through this with you. One of the greatest lies we tell ourselves is that people don't care, or are too busy. As awkward or unnatural as it may seem to reach out and invite people into the hardships of life, it is how we were designed - to lean into the love of God and then love each other.
