DAILY PRAYER

Day One -Monday, February 20th.

LISTEN

When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild. But whoever obeys the law is joyful.

O God, with all our hearts, we long for You. Come, transform us into Christ-centred, Spirit-empowered, Mission-focused people, multiplying disciples everywhere.

REFLECT

Reflect on the Vision Prayer of the Christian and Missionary Alliance and Proverbs 29:18. Then, reflecting on our congregation and our location in the city, pray and ask the Lord to show us what our vision should be that will guide us in the mission to which we are called.

DAILY PRAYER

DAILY PRAYER

Day Three -Wednesday, February 22nd.

LISTEN

But that isn't what you learned about Christ. Since you have heard about Jesus and have learned the truth that comes from him, throw off your old sinful nature and your former way of life, which is corrupted by lust and deception. Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy.

PRAY

Lord, we turn away from our former selves and towards you. Spirit renew us.

REFLECT

Lent is a time to remember the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is a time to draw near to God by giving up something that might be hindering you from living in relationship with the Creator of the universe. Letting go of something that has a hold on your time and attention will allow you to refocus on God through reading His Word, reflecting in prayer, and taking time to worship. Individuals have let go of meal times to focus on prayer, but they have also given up watching the news, scrolling through Facebook or engaging in a hobby or sport.

Please note your commitment to let go so that you can take hold of your time to connect with God.

DAILY PRAYER

Day Four - Thursday, February 23rd.

LISTEN

"I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through their message. I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me.

"I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me.

PRAY

Lord, let us be one - as you are one.

In John 17 is recorded Jesus' high priestly prayer of intercession. Verses 20 through 23 focus on Jesus' prayer for unity in the church. Reflect on the following verses in prayer, asking the questions, 'In what ways is Crosspoint serving in unity?' and 'How can I contribute to the mission of Crosspoint?'
