Crosspoint Church has entered a time of transition, a hinge moment. What does the Bible say about such times?

In Isaiah, the Lord was preparing Israel for what lay ahead. They were going to face uncertain circumstances, questions about their purpose and questions about how to move forward. This sounds like 'transition'.

The following verses will be the focus of our message this Sunday.

Isaiah 43:1, 2 But now thus says the Lord, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; have called you by name, you are mine.

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you;

Isaiah 43:10, 11 "You are my witnesses," declares the Lord, "and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe me and understand that I am he. Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me. I, I am the Lord, and besides me there is no saviour.

Isaiah 43:18, 19 "Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.
