

BIBLE READING PLAN

Each week has six days of reading and select verses from Romans 8 to memorize. Work on these verses each week to memorize the whole chapter by the end of the summer.

The first column continues through Israel's story chronologically through and after exile starting in Daniel and including other prophets. The second column walks slowly through the gospel of Matthew. With just around twenty verses a day, this reading would be great for discipleship.

READING GUIDE

Ezra's Example

→ PRAY Preparation (Ez. 8:23)

Thank God for speaking to us and revealing himself in his Word (2 Timothy 3:16, Heb 4:12). Ask God to help you understand so that you might know him and make him known!

- What sort of writing is this? (Historical/Narrative, Sermon/Letter, Poem/Song, Prophetic/Apocalyptic)
- What is the context or circumstance surrounding your reading? (Time period, Author, Addressee)

→ READ Observation (Neh. 8:1-8)

What does it say?

- What sticks out and surprises you in this text?
- What repetition, key words, commands, characters, or climax did you observe?
- What's the main focus and emphasis of the text?

→ STUDY Interpretation (Ez. 7:10)

What did it mean for them?

- What did you learn about God and the Gospel?
- What did you learn about yourself and the world?
- What questions do you have?

→ DO Application (Ez. 7:10)

What does it mean for you?

- How might you sum up your reading in your own words?
- What wrong beliefs and actions do you need to repent and confess?
- What do you need to believe and do in response to God's Word?

→ TEACH Multiplication (Ez. 7:10)

What does it mean for others?

- What can you share with another Christian to encourage them to follow Christ?
- What can you share with a Non-Christian so they might consider following Christ?

SCRIPTURE MEMORY

Challenge yourself to hide God's word in your heart this year, whether in reciting our three-verse benediction or memorizing a whole chapter!

BENEDICTION

Romans 16:25-27
