



The goal of the twos and threes room is not only to make them feel comfortable and loved, but to also introduce them to God's story of creation, fall, redemption, and restoration. Your child will learn one of these 4 parts of God's story each month through a story told with pictures on a board, a corresponding song, and related activities. The story and activities stay the same throughout the whole month because kids at this age learn through repetition. Throughout the course of a year, your child will hear the entirety of God's story repeated three times, with the goal for them to understand God's story and how they fit into it.
