Matthew 15:21-28 (ESV)

The Faith of a Canaanite Woman

²¹ And Jesus went away from there and withdrew to the district of Tyre and Sidon. ²² And behold, a Canaanite woman from that region came out and was crying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David; my daughter is severely oppressed by a demon." ²³ But he did not answer her a word. And his disciples came and begged him, saying, "Send her away, for she is crying out after us." ²⁴ He answered, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." ²⁵ But she came and knelt before him, saying, "Lord, help me." ²⁶ And he answered, "It is not right to take the children's bread and throw it to the dogs." ²⁷ She said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their masters' table." ²⁸ Then Jesus answered her, "O woman, great is your faith! Be it done for you as you desire." And her daughter was healed instantly.

- Look at the map in the back of your Bible. Find Tyre and Sidon.
- What does Canaanite mean? (Here it means a non-Jewish pagan person living in that region.)
- Who does the lost sheep refer to? (At this point, the focus is on the Jews [Matthew 10:6]– but later through the apostles, the gospel is to go to the Gentiles!)
- What is faith? (Having full confidence in the goodness of God, even though we do not see Him.)
- How did the Canaanite woman show faith?
