PRE-KINDERGARTEN AND KINDERGARTEN COMMUNITY LEADER

JOB DESCRIPTION

Teach lessons from "The Gospel Project" curriculum as edited by the FM team, facilitate discussions, and lead Bible story activities for preschool kids (aged four to six, or pre-K/Kindergarten). Direct the preschool 3D Leaders on how to serve/assist throughout the lesson. Provide helpful feedback to parents on kids. These leaders are patient but persistent, as preschoolers may not respond to a question the first time.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Prep ahead of time, before Sunday's community group
 - o Read over the lesson provided by FM leadership, two to three times
 - Become familiar with the main idea of the bible story, be able to explain the main idea simply for PreK/K level and how to relates to them in their context
 - Spend time memorizing the Bible verse and be able to teach it, listen to song several times
 - Read over the Missions Moment and pray for Felix
- Lead Sunday morning Community Group
 - Welcome children
 - Coloring pages
 - Play Bible video
 - o Explain how the passage applies
 - Play memory verse song
 - Missions Moment
 - Retell bible story with puppets: Retell the story using PUPPETS and ask review questions
 - Worship: Put out bucket of instruments and play music from computer desktop. Allow kids to choose an instrument. Play and shake, march in a circle, play your instruments loud, soft, up high, down
 - Snack: Draw sticks and give out "jobs for the morning. Allow kids to set up for snack according to their job. Pray for each kid while they are eating.
 - Free play: Get out puzzles, cars, balls, play 'duck, duck, goose', 'I-spy', 'hide and go seek,'
 etc.
- Facilitate a safe and welcoming environment where children can grow in their knowledge of with Jesus Christ
- Clean up area, trash, and bins
- Foster a spirit of commitment and ownership among the team
- Collaborate and communicate with 3D Leader during morning activities
- Think creatively and work to communicate the lesson to the children in a way that they understand and appreciate
- Oversee the check in and out process, making sure all infants have appropriate tags and logged in attendance sheet and that parents have the right tag when checking out
- Communicate needs/concerns such as ratio adjustments with Coordinator and FM Director
- Train new volunteers on the team with the processes, schedule, and rhythms of PreK/K class

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Pass background check
- Must be a member at the Well Community Church
- Must be comfortable engaging with parents and families
- Must not be immunocompromised
- Arrive at 8:15 am attend huddle, pray, and prepare for the morning
