2021-2022 TUITION RATES

Young 5s through grade 8 • Preschool • Infant & Toddler Care

Grades K-8 Tuition 2021-2022

First child in your family: \$4080. Second child: \$2428.
Additional children in the household: no additional cost.

Discounted tuition for children or grandchildren of active members of Trinity

First child in a family: \$3315. Next sibling in family: \$1663.
Additional siblings: no additional cost.

Discounted tuition for children of active members of other LCMS churches

First child in your family: \$3315. Second child: \$1663.
Additional children in the household: no additional cost.

Young 5s

Full time tuition (five days per week) is identical to the rates above.
Half time enrollment (8:00 to 11:30 each day) is 50% of those rates.
Additional childcare for breaks or snow days is not included in these costs.

Additional costs

Each family is charged a \$100. application fee, due with the enrollment papers, if enrolled before May 21 they will receive a \$50 discount. This fee is nonrefundable and is separate from tuition costs.

Technology Fee of \$100. per student.

Before- and after-school care is available through our Early Childhood Center, at a cost of \$6.00 per hour. Payments are due in advance.

Payment schedule

Tuition is expected in advance and may be made in one, two, or ten installments. If tuition is paid in full by July 15 there is a 3% discount.

Single payment for the year is due by July 15.

Due dates for two installments: August 20 and January 20.

Due dates for ten even payments are the 15th of the following months:

August, September, October, November, December, January, February, March, April, May.

Helping Cover Costs

Scholarships are available based on financial need. Families may apply online through the FACTS site by using the link at www.tlsjackson.com. Applications received by March 30 will be considered for awards in April. Applications submitted after that deadline will be processed when the committee meets at the end of the year. Those submitted during the summer will be considered when received, if funds remain.

Using TRIP (Tuition Reduction Incentive Program) is a simple way to earn money for tuition or child care fees. When you purchase a cash/gift card for a participating business, a portion of your purchase stays in your TLS account. Using TRIP cards to buy gas, groceries, cups of coffee, or even furniture can quickly help pay your tuition or fees.
