#### **About the Lord's Supper at Trinity**

The Lord's Supper, also called Communion, is a time for Christians to meet with the Savior to be strengthened in our faith. We invite those who are baptized members of an evangelical church to participate. As part of our worship service, we come forward to the table by using the center aisles. Take one of the double stacked cups that contain bread on the bottom and grape juice on the top. Return to your seat using the outside aisles and join in singing. Children who have not yet publicly professed their faith in Christ should refrain from participating in communion. Trinity has resources to help assist you in the process of your child becoming a communing member and participating in communion. Gluten free communion bread is labeled and located in the center tray on the table. This also serves as our offering time. Offering plates are located up front. We ask that you give as the Lord leads you to help support Trinity's mission locally and globally. Our giving comes from an understanding that God has blessed us generously in Christ.

# TRINITY'S CORE VALUES

- 1. Kingdom Living (Matthew 5:1-12) We endeavor to live with humility and a courageous commitment to Christ. We recognize that we are sinners and model repentance in our daily living that we might reflect the priorities of God's kingdom consistent with being followers of Christ.

- 5. Community Outreach (Acts 17:22-34) We communicate the life transforming truth of the gospel to any who will listen so that the church's demographics reflect the community God has called us to serve. We engage in outreach that is understandable and we trust for God's Spirit to move in the hearts of those who hear. We initiate into the messiness of life with love and mercy rather than foster a come and see mentality.
