

Read: Psalm 122

Ice Breaker:

- Share a moment when you remember being homesick. Where were you and why did you long to be home?

Discussion

- Discuss with your group what Tim meant when he said, "Peace is found in a person, not a place."
- How have we lived seeking peace in other ways and places?
- What does the word "shalom" mean and what would that look like in your home?
- How do we experience true shalom personally and corporately? (hint: Ephesians 2:19)
- Referring to Psalm 8-9, what does shalom look like?
- What would you say are God's "house rules?"
- Tim mentioned that we don't gather together for a song or a sermon, why do we come to God's House?
- Are you glad when they say, "let us go to the house of the Lord?" To community group? Daily personal worship? To pray for a friend?

Pray (from the worship folder)

- Worship the LORD for his gift of welcoming us into His home and into His family.
- Confess that we have not lived in light of the shalom that God has given us through his Son.
- Thank Him for his redeeming work to make us "...saints and members of the household of God."
- Pray that God would bear the fruit of peace in you for the good of your neighbor.
