English Language Class - Class resumes Wednesday, **August 21** from 6:00-7:30 p.m. Classes are held each Wednesday from 6:00-7:30 p.m. for anyone in our community who wants to improve their pronunciation and accent and feel more comfortable conversing at work, at school, and in the community. Free childcare is provided.

Sermon Series - September 1 we will begin a three-part series on Romans 12. In this series, we'll consider certain disciplines of the Christian church such as worship, spiritual gifts, and service. Plan on joining us for this series trusting that the Lord will grow each of us in our commitment to him and his church.

Women's Thursday Morning Bible study - John Stott's study, *Acts: Seeing the Spirit at Work* will be the basis for lessons in this year's study of the book of Acts at the Women's Thursday Morning Bible study beginning **Sept. 5**.
