English Language Class - Classes are held each Wednesday from 6:00-7:30 p.m. for anyone in our community who wants to improve their pronunciation and accent and feel more comfortable conversing at work, at school, and in the community. Free childcare is provided.

Sermon Series - September 1 we will begin a three-part series on Romans 12. In this series, we'll consider certain disciplines of the Christian church such as worship, spiritual gifts, and service.
