

Dear family of TPC,

This Sunday we will have our first live stream worship service at 9:30 a.m. We will try to have access to it by 9:15 a.m. You can find the service on our Facebook page as we will be using Facebook Live. Here is the link with directions <https://www.facebook.com/trinitymboro/>. If you access this through your mobile phone, it may prompt you to sign onto your own Facebook account first. Once signed in on your phone, click on "Posts" below our name and logo for the video.

On the Facebook site, you can access the bulletin as well as the lyrics to the songs and the children's bulletins. You can also find these on our website under the Worship tab "Bulletin Archives". You can either print them out, open a split-screen on your computer or use another device such as your phone or I-pad. The liturgy will be very similar to what we do every Lord's Day. For the songs, scroll past the end of the bulletin. As for giving, you may give online by clicking the link [here](#) or on our website under the "About Us" tab and "Giving to TPC" or you can mail your offering to the church.

In regards to the service, I will not be leading this Sunday. The reason is that I was informed yesterday that while we were in Texas, I and my family, were exposed to a family member who possibly has COVID-19. With so many unknowns, we have been told to act as if we were exposed which means we are to self-quarantine.

It pains me to not be leading you in worship this Sunday. Thankfully, Weston Duke has offered to lead the liturgy in my place. Please pray for him as he leads and for Pleun as he preaches this Lord's Day.

I know this way of worshipping is not ideal but it is the best we can do under such circumstances. Whether you are with your family or alone, I would encourage you to participate in this service by utilizing the words of response, the songs, and the prayers. For even though we will be watching, we are not spectators anymore under separate roofs than we are when we are under one roof. Rather, as always, we are actors in worship...actors responding to our gracious God who calls us to worship Him in Spirit and in truth.

Practically, let me encourage to do the following:

- Access the Facebook page the night before
- Download the bulletin and song lyrics the night before
- Go over the bulletin and song lyrics beforehand as a way to prepare your hearts and minds for worship
