

PASTOR: Christ yesterday and today, the Beginning and the End, Alpha and Omega, all time belongs to him, and all ages;

PEOPLE: **To him be glory and power through every age and forever.**

PASTOR: This is the day when our Lord Jesus passed from death to life. Throughout the world Christians celebrate the awesome power of God. As we hear his word and proclaim all that God has done, we can be confident that we shall share in his victory over death and live with him forever in the New Creation!

PASTOR: Now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the first fruits of them that slept. O death, where is your sting? O grave, where is your victory?

PEOPLE: **Give thanks unto the Lord, for he is good: for his mercy endures forever.**

PASTOR: Christ is risen!

PEOPLE: **He is risen indeed!**

PASTOR: Christ is risen!

*Prayer of Adoration

PASTOR: Let us pray that we may walk in the risen life of Christ in glory:

ALL: **Lord of life and power, who through the mighty resurrection of your Son overcame the old order of sin and death to make all things new in him: Grant that we, being dead to sin and alive to you in Jesus Christ, may reign with him in glory; to whom with you and the Holy Spirit be praise and honor, glory and might, now and for all eternity. Amen.**

Proclamations of the Resurrection

- PASTOR:** Let us now proclaim the reality of the resurrection:
- PEOPLE:** **He who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and bring us into his presence.**
- WORSHIP TEAM:** *Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death, and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!*
- PASTOR:** How can we who died to sin still live in it? Do we not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?
- PEOPLE:** **We were buried therefore with him through baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in the newness of life.**
- WORSHIP TEAM:** *Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death, and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!*
- PASTOR:** If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised from the dead. And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain.
- PEOPLE:** **But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a man has come the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive!**
- WORSHIP TEAM:** *Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death, and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!*
- PASTOR:** There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus!
(Romans 8:1)
- PEOPLE:** **Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.**
- ALL:** *Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death, and upon those in the tombs bestowing life! (3X)*

*Extending God's Welcome of Peace

- PASTOR:** Christ has been raised from the dead! Therefore, let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts. To this peace we are called as members of a single body. Christ is risen!
- PEOPLE:** **He is risen indeed!**

Greet one another with the gospel saying, "Christ is risen!" to which the response is "He is risen indeed!"

PASTOR: Christian, what do we confess concerning the gospel?

ALL: Concerning the gospel, we confess, as a matter of first importance, that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures and because this is true we can and do proclaim loudly: "Death is swallowed up in victory! O death, where is your victory? O death where is your sting?" Thanks be to God who has given us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! Amen!

The Great Thanksgiving

PASTOR: The Lord be with you.

PEOPLE: **And with your spirit.**

PASTOR: Lift up your hearts.

PEOPLE: **We lift them up to the Lord.**

PEOPLE: **It is right to give him thanks and praise.**

PASTOR: The gifts of God for the people of God. Take them in remembrance that Christ died for you and feed on him in your hearts by faith and with thanksgiving. Let us partake of the feast!

Holy Communion (see insert)

Trinity Presbyterian Church welcomes all baptized Christians who are willing to forsake their sin and trust in Christ for salvation, and who are members in good standing of a congregation that proclaims the gospel, to receive Holy Communion with us. Baptized covenant children who have not made profession of faith before the elders should abstain from receiving communion until they are received as communing members by the session. TPC serves wine and grape juice for communion. The **clear** cups contain wine and the **purple** cups contain grape juice. Gluten free communion bread is in the glass dish in the serving basket.
