## SERMON TEXT – Hebrews 12: 3 - 17

Consider him who \_\_\_\_\_ from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted. <sup>4</sup>In your struggle \_\_\_\_\_ sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. <sup>5</sup>And have you \_\_\_\_\_ the exhortation that addresses you as sons?

“My son, do not regard \_\_\_\_\_ the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when \_\_\_\_\_ by him.

<sup>6</sup>For the Lord disciplines the one he \_\_\_\_\_, and chastises every \_\_\_\_\_ whom he receives.”

<sup>7</sup>It is for discipline that you have to \_\_\_\_\_. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not \_\_\_\_\_? <sup>8</sup>If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. <sup>9</sup>Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we \_\_\_\_\_ them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live? <sup>10</sup>For they disciplined us for a short time as it seemed best to them, but he disciplines us for our \_\_\_\_\_, that we may share his holiness. <sup>11</sup>For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the \_\_\_\_\_ fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.

<sup>12</sup>Therefore lift your \_\_\_\_\_ hands and strengthen your weak \_\_\_\_\_, <sup>13</sup>and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be put out of joint but rather be healed. <sup>14</sup>Strive for peace with everyone, and for the \_\_\_\_\_ without which no one will see the Lord. <sup>15</sup>See to it that no one fails to obtain the \_\_\_\_\_ of God; that no “\_\_\_\_\_ of bitterness” springs up and causes trouble, and by it many become defiled; <sup>16</sup>that no one is sexually immoral or unholy like Esau, who \_\_\_\_\_ his birthright for a single meal. <sup>17</sup>For you know that afterward, when he desired to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no chance to \_\_\_\_\_, though he sought it with tears.
