Matthew 8:1-17 (*Listen & fill in the blanks*)

When he came down from the mountain, great crowds followed him.² And behold, a leper^[a] came to him and knelt before him, saying, "Lord, if you will, you can make me clean."³ And _____^[b] stretched out his hand and touched him, saying, "I will; be clean."
