Sermon Scripture -Matthew 3:1-12- Listen and fill in the blanks

In those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea² and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."³ This is he who was spoken of through the prophet Isaiah: "A _____ of one calling in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.'"^[a]⁴ John's clothes were made of camel's hair, and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild _____.⁵ People went out to him from Jerusalem and all Judea and the whole region of the Jordan.⁶ Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the _____ River.⁷ But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to where he was baptizing, he said to them: "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the coming _____?"⁸ Produce fruit in keeping with repentance.⁹ And do not think you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.'
