They went across the lake to the region of the Gerasenes.

<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>2</sup> When Jesus got out of the \_\_\_\_\_, a man with an impure spirit came from the tombs to meet him. <sup>3</sup> This man lived in the tombs, and no one could \_\_\_\_\_ him anymore, not even with a chain. <sup>4</sup> For he had often been chained hand and foot, but he tore the chains apart and broke \_\_\_\_\_ irons on his feet. <sup>11</sup> A large herd of pigs was feeding \_\_\_\_\_ the nearby hillside. <sup>12</sup> The demons begged Jesus, "Send us among the pigs; allow us to go into them." <sup>13</sup> He \_\_\_\_\_ them permission, and the impure spirits came out and went into the pigs. The herd, about two thousand in number, rushed down \_\_\_\_\_ steep bank into the lake and were drowned.
