⁶ I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the _____ of Christ and are turning to a different gospel—
⁷ not that there is another one, but there are some who trouble you and want to distort the _____ of Christ. ⁸ But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one _____ preached to you, let him be accursed. ⁹ As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to _____ a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed. ¹⁰ For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please _____, I would not be a servant^[a] of Christ. ¹¹ For I would have you know, brothers, that the _____ that was preached by me is not man's gospel.^[b] ¹² For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of _____ Christ. ¹³ For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to _____ it. ¹⁴ And I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own _____ among my people, so extremely zealous was I for the traditions of my fathers. ¹⁵ But when he who had set me apart before I was _____,^[c] and who called me by his grace, ¹⁶ was pleased to reveal his Son to^[d] me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately _____ with anyone;^[e] ¹⁷ nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me, but I went away into _____, and returned again to Damascus.
