### Sermon Scripture –Revelation 4-5 (listen and fill in the blanks)

4 After this I looked, and behold, a \_\_\_\_ standing open in heaven! And the first voice, which I had heard speaking to me like a trumpet, said, "Come up here, and I will \_\_\_\_ you what must take place after this."<sup>2</sup> At once I was in the Spirit, and behold, a throne stood in heaven, with one seated on the \_\_\_\_.<sup>3</sup> And he who sat there had the appearance of jasper and carnelian, and around the throne was a \_\_\_\_ that had the appearance of an emerald.<sup>4</sup> Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and seated on the thrones were twenty-four \_\_\_\_, clothed in white garments, with golden crowns on their heads.<sup>5</sup> From the throne came flashes of lightning, and rumblings<sup>[a]</sup> and peals of \_\_\_\_, and before the throne were burning seven torches of fire, which are the seven spirits of God,<sup>6</sup> and before the throne there was as it were a sea of glass, like crystal.
