## We Confess Our Faith | WESTMINSTER LARGER CATECHISM QUESTION 45

How does Christ execute or carry out the office of a King?

***Christ carries out the office of a king in calling a people out of the world to himself<sup>1</sup> and giving them officers<sup>2</sup>, laws<sup>3</sup>, and censures by which he visibly governs them<sup>4</sup>; in bestowing saving grace on the elect<sup>5</sup>, rewarding their obedience<sup>6</sup> and correcting them for their sins<sup>7</sup>, preserving and supporting them during all their temptations and sufferings<sup>8</sup>, restraining and overcoming all their enemies<sup>9</sup>, and powerfully ordering all things for his own glory<sup>10</sup> and for their good<sup>11</sup>; and also in taking vengeance on the rest, who do not know God and do not obey the Gospel.<sup>12</sup>***
