SERMON :: MARK 9:28-29

28 AND WHEN HE HAD ENTERED THE HOUSE, HIS DISCIPLES ASKED HIM PRIVATELY, "WHY COULD WE NOT CAST IT OUT?" 29 AND HE SAID TO THEM, "THIS KIND CANNOT BE DRIVEN OUT BY ANYTHING BUT PRAYER."

Questions for personal or group reflection:

1. What are some "normal" things that you are excited to get back to? What are some "normal" things that God may be calling us to move on from?
2. The context of these verses mention faithlessness and unbelief. What role does faith and belief play in spiritual power and prayer?
3. What are areas of your life in which you are relying on your proficiency when God is calling you to live a life of dependency? *Note: being proficient in something is not bad. But often we try to be proficient in areas of life we weren't meant to be.
4. To be a praying church means that the individual members must be praying people. Do you struggle with prayer? How can you become a person of prayer?



PRAYER FOR OUR HEARTS

Lord, my heart ought to be on fire for your name and for your glory. Yet, it is tepid toward you, tangled up in the cares of the world. Release me, O God, from the desires of the flesh and set me loose to pursue you whole heartedly.

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Fill my heart with your Spirit and revive me again.

My heart is deceitful above all things and desperately sick and I can't understand it. Search me and know my heart, try me and know my thoughts and see if there be any grievous way in me and lead me in the way everlasting.

Lord, I give you my heart. Teach me to seek you and love you with all of it. Amen.

PRAYER POINTS:

- Pray a prayer confessing sin.
- Ask the Lord to set your heart ablaze for his glory and his name.
- Ask the spirit to stir your heart to love Jesus above all others.
- Ask the lord for whole-hearted devotion to him and a sacrificial love for others.
- Ask the spirit to posture your heart before him to be aware of his presence and power in your life.
- Spend a moment giving over your heart to God.
- Pray for revival.
