SERMON :: 2 CORINTHIANS 4:16-18

¹⁶ SO WE DO NOT LOSE HEART. THOUGH OUR OUTER SELF IS WASTING AWAY, OUR INNER SELF IS BEING RENEWED DAY BY DAY. ¹⁷ FOR THIS LIGHT MOMENTARY AFFLICTION IS PREPARING FOR US AN ETERNAL WEIGHT OF GLORY BEYOND ALL COMPARISON, ¹⁸ AS WE LOOK NOT TO THE THINGS THAT ARE SEEN BUT TO THE THINGS THAT ARE UNSEEN. FOR THE THINGS THAT ARE SEEN ARE TRANSIENT, BUT THE THINGS THAT ARE UNSEEN ARE ETERNAL.

Questions for personal or group reflection:

1. Suffering is a part of life. What/where/who do you typically run to in seasons of tribulation?
2. Paul says, “So we do not lose heart.” What does it mean to lose heart? And what are circumstances that may cause you to lose heart?
3. How does the news that you are being renewed day by day by the Spirit change the way you think about the gospel?
4. What are practical ways that we can help each other “raise our vision”?
5. Spend some time sharing burdens and praying for one another (or sharing your burdens with God and sitting in his presence).



PRAYER FOR OUR HOMES

Father, we are grateful for your provision of physical homes. We ask that you would fill them with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Lord, we ask that the fruit of your Spirit would establish the culture of our homes and direct the expectations for our relationships.

Lord, we ask for the wisdom to make you the center of our homes. That all that takes place within our homes would be an overflow of a devoted life to you. We desire to love You Lord with all of our heart, with all of our souls, and all of our might. Impress these words on our hearts. Implore us to speak of Your holiness and your commands when we sit or when we walk, when we lie down and when we rise. Bind them to our hearts, and keep them at the forefront of our minds. We want your ways to be evident within our homes. Provide us the desire to make it so.

We ask that our homes would become places of Gospel proclamation and hospitality. Create within our homes a physical space where grace is spoken of and demonstrated. Where people hear of your name and feel your physical presence through the love of your people. We desire our homes to be a refuge for those who are hurting, alone, and lowly, just as you have been and continue to be our refuge. Let our homes point to you Jesus.

God, our homes are Yours. Our lives are Yours. Please use them for your glory and the good of our family, church, friends, and community. Amen

PRAYER POINTS:

- Thank God for his provision of a home.
- Ask God that you would be empowered to make your home a space where the fruit of the Spirit increases and is experienced by all who are in your home.
- Pray against worldliness directing the priorities of your home. That you and your house would seek the Lord only, and would not chase after other gods.
- Ask that your home would be a place where faith in Jesus Christ is passed onto younger generations, neighbors, etc. Ask God to use your home as place where people rescued from sin and grow into Christlikeness.
