I. The Daring Disobedience of False Teachers

- A. They dare God with <u>Independence</u> by: relying on the dreams and visions of their own mind.
 - i. Jer 23:25-32
 - ii. John 17:17
 - iii. Col 2:18-19
- B. They dare God with *Immorality* by: defiling the flesh. 8b
 - i. Jude repeats this warning 1:4, 6, 7
 - ii. This occurs both in their teaching and living
 - 1 Tim 6:3; Col 2:23
 - 2 Pet 2:2, 18-19
- C. They dare God with *Insubordination* by rejecting authority. 8c
 - i. Rejecting the authority of God's Lordship
 - Jude 1:4; Tit 1:16
 - ii. Rejecting the authority of Scripture
- D. They dare God with <u>Irreverence</u> by: unrestrained Blasphemies.
