- 2. They are like <u>Balaam</u> who was: greedy for money and wealth

  - iv. Tit 1:11; 2 Pet 2:4; Matt 23:25
- 3. They are like Korah who was openly rebellious
  - Num 16

4. Like <u>hidden reefs</u>, they are dangerous and unseen

"Hidden Reefs..."

- i. They look like other Christians Matt 7:15; 2 Cor 11:14
- ii. They often have the title or position of spiritual leadership
- iii. They often oppose the truth indirectly

- 5. Like <u>selfish shepherds</u>, they care for themselves not the flock
  - i. The word caring is the verb "to shepherd"
  - ii. Ez 34:1-6; Jn 10:13
- 6. Like waterless clouds, they promise relief but are useless
  - Prov 25:14
- 7. Like <u>dead trees</u>, they are fruitless, lifeless, and barren
  - i. False teachers lack fruit Gal 5:22-23; Heb 13:15; Eph 5:9
  - ii. You will know them by their fruits Matt 7:16-18
- 8. Like <u>raging waves</u>, they churn up and leave behind filth
- 9. Like wandering stars, they lead others astray
