The start of 2020 has been filled with some amazing opportunities to witness God's faithfulness as He builds His church here in South-east Asia. We are eager to share with you how God is working through your support and prayers during our family's upcoming visit to the States. Our family has been planning this trip for the past few months and the kids are really excited to visit their cousins and friends. We will be in the States for 5 weeks starting on March 20th until the 28th of April and hope to visit with as many of our family and ministry partners as possible.

Sadly though Mam and Gracie will not be able to join our family during this trip. Gracie has completed 9th grade and will need to remain in Thailand to test and register for the start of her adventure as a high schooler. We wish that they both could travel with us, but due to the uncertainty of test dates and registration details, we felt it was wiser for Mam and Gracie to remain in Thailand. I will fly back with Joy, Hope, and Kyle and we will spend a shorter amount of time in the States, so that the whole family can take a short trip to Singapore before school starts again on May 14th.

We all wish that Mam and Gracie could travel with us, but we understand that as our children get older the opportunities to travel as a family are going to become rarer. For this trip though, I will be traveling with Joy, Hope and Kyle which means this will be the first time the boys are not outnumbered by the girls and that we will all fit into one hotel room and a compact car if needed (as long as we don't have a lot of luggage). Speaking of luggage since there will be four of us traveling, we will be able to bring more goodies with us to share with people we meet. This means we will be able to bring a lot more coffee and tea for those who are interested. ***If you would like to pre-order some coffee, please let us know so that we can prepare enough to cover all of our coffee cravings.***

Our family is grateful for this opportunity to travel back to visit our family and supporters and are excited to share with you in person all that God is doing to grow His church here in South-east Asia. I have listed out a tentative travel schedule for our family's time in the States. Tentative schedule for time spent in the States:

March 20th leave from Thailand and arrive in Boise around 8:30 PM.

March 21 -27th in Jerome area (Speaking at Magic Valley Bible Church the 22nd)

March 28 - 31st in Hailey area (Speaking at Calvary Bible Church the 29th)

April 1-7th in Jerome area (Sunday the 5th open to visit or share at your church)

April 8 - 18th in Pocatello area (Sunday the 12th attending University Bible Church)

April 19th (Open to visit or share at your church)

April 21 - 27th in Boise area. (Sunday the 26th open to visit or share at your church)

April 28th fly back to Thailand.

As you can see from the schedule above, our time in the States will be shorter than previous visits, yet we still plan to connect with as many of our family and ministry partners as possible during these 5 weeks we will be Stateside. Praise:

The kids are completing their school year. Kyle (3rd grade) and Hope (5th grade) have finished the first week of March. (Please pray for them). Joy (7th grade) and Gracie (9th grade) finished their exams last week. They will start the new school year in May.

Our church is growing and we are rejoicing at the increase in visitors and regular attenders joining us each Sunday. We have had an increase of young families so Mam and others are helping to develop a nursery and children's church program.

Hearts Redeemed Ministries has a new resource center. Last week Mam found a building which will serve as a new resource center to house the ministry. We are slowly moving in as we try to furnish the 3 story building which will host, a biblical counseling office, a resource center, counseling training, and a guest room for missionaries and people needing a temporary place to stay. There might also be a coffee or tea shop one day in the future.

We were able to purchase our tickets back to the States at a good price (\$4,175 for all four of us) and are trusting that our flights will not be canceled to the Coronavirus outbreak which is affecting most of travel in Asia and that we will raise some extra money to cover the costs of the flights and travel to and from the States.

Prayer:

Our family as we travel during our trip to the States. Pray for protection and provision for the four of us who are traveling as well as for Mam and Grace who will be staying here in Thailand. The Coronavirus is a concern and many flights are being canceled due to the outbreak. We trust that our flights will not be affected and that we will be able to return to Thailand once our visit in the States is complete.

Our family and ministry are growing and as a result we need to raise an additional \$1,500 in monthly support to cover the growing expenses. During our time in the States we will be looking to raise the additional support so that our family and HRM can continue to serve the local church here in Thailand. ***We are praying for 2 new churches and 10 new families to join our support team.
