6 statements explaining Jesus' self-emptying

- 1. He left the *throne-room* of heavenly *worship*
- 2. He <u>allowed</u> his divine glory to be <u>veiled</u> - John 17:4-5
- 3. He left the unique <u>face to face</u> fellowship - John 17:5, 24
- 4. He gave up the independent use of some divine attributes
- 5. He took the <u>status</u> of a lowly <u>bond-slave</u> - Mark 10:45
- 6. He entered into <u>genuine humanity</u> - Heb 2:17; 5:8

III. The Humility of his *obedience* unto *death* on a cross vs 8

- A. He humbled himself in death Joh 10:17
- B. He became sin's curse for us Gal 3:10,13
