“What Should We Do When We Don’t Know What to Do?”

2 Chronicles 20:1-30

We face decisions everyday: What should I wear? What should I eat? How should I spend my time? There are also times in our lives where we face a fork in the road and don’t know what to do. Although the Bible may not tell us exactly what to do, Scripture gives us principles that will help us make a decision.

In this lesson of “Honest Answers for Honest Questions,” we’ll discuss an incredible story from 2 Chronicles of a people of God who were at a crossroads and a wonderful Savior Who came to their rescue. As we keep our eyes on Jesus, He will help us in whatever situation we face.



KNOWING GOD

What were some things Jehoshaphat and the people did before their enemies arrived (see v. 3-5; 12-22)?

How did God intervene on behalf of His people (see v. 22-23)? How do you see His sovereignty and our responsibility play out in this text?

How did the people respond after God's intervention (v.25-29)?



GROWING TOGETHER

What do you tend to do when you don't know what to do?

Describe a time when you faced a difficult decision. What were the results of it? How did you handle it?

Notice (see v. 4, 13, 18-22, 26-30) that the people responded in community. When you meet a fork in the road, why is it important to rely on others for help?



SERVING OTHERS

How can you serve another person who faces a difficult decision? How should you counsel them?

As we make decisions, how can we better serve and glorify our Lord?



IN YOUR FAMILY...

- a) How do you and your family make decisions? Discuss together.
- b) As a family, create a list of things you can do whenever you face a difficult decision. As time moves on, whenever any member of the family is at a crossroad, review the list together.
