**Matthew 28:16-20**

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR CHILDREN (FAMILY DEVOTIONS)

1. A disciple is a student who is learning how to be a teacher. How does this help us understand what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ?
2. Define "authority" for your children. Jesus said all authority has been given to him. This means that He has both the authority to forgive our sins and send us on a mission to tell the world about what He has done for us on the cross. How does this give us freedom and purpose at the same time?
