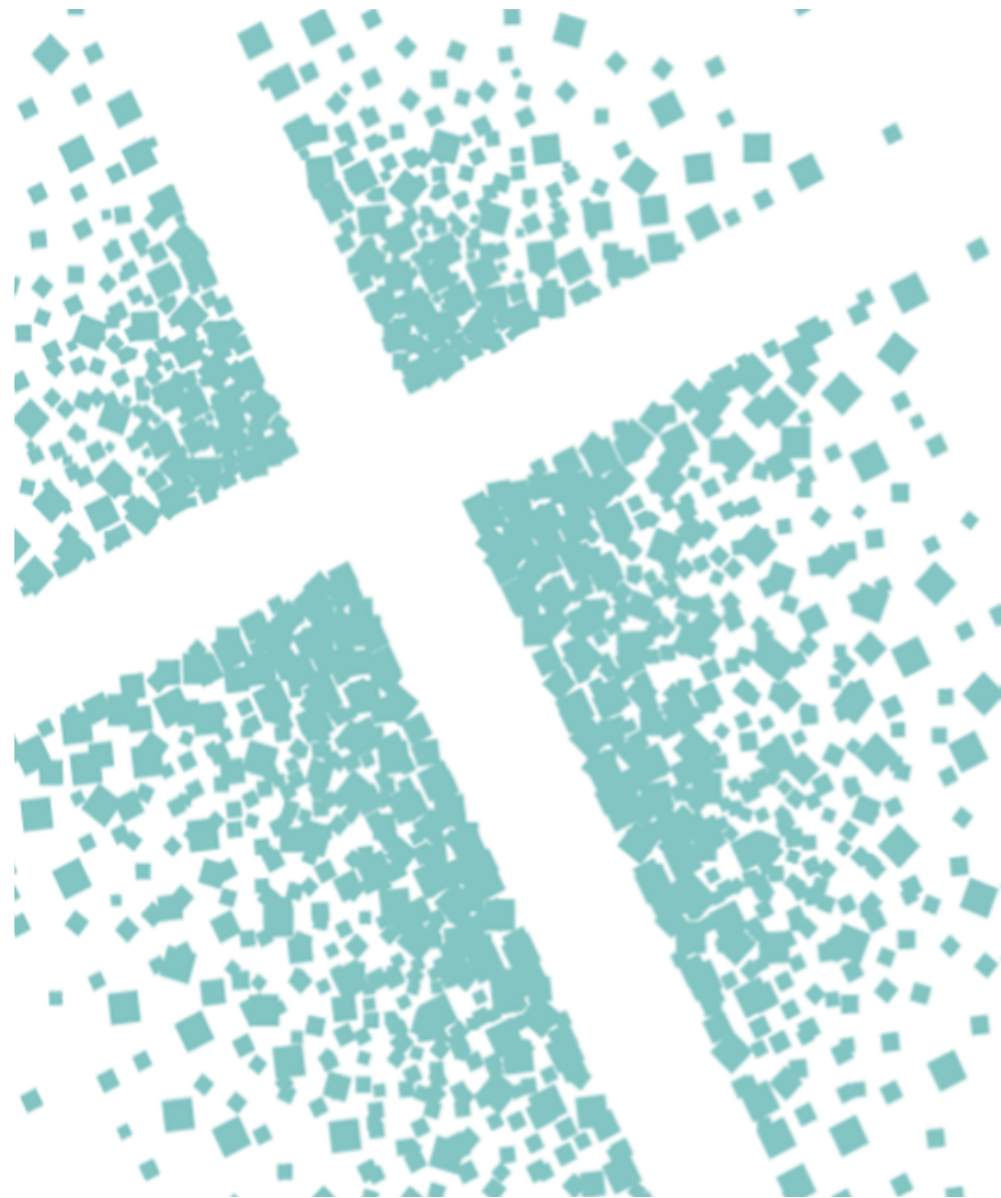
## MEN'S RETREAT 2024
