On behalf of Victory in Christ Christian Center, we are pleased to offer students currently attending a technical school, college, or university as a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior the opportunity to apply for the Dr. Myles and Ruth Munroe Scholarship.

The **Dr. Myles and Ruth Munroe Scholarship** honors the legacy of leadership exemplified by the late Dr. Myles and Ruth Munroe. As the Myles Munroe Institute's founder, Dr. Munroe sought to serve the spiritual, social, and personal development needs of individuals who desired to learn and grow in their relationship with God.

The recipient will receive a **one-time** award of \$500, disbursed in two separate payments of \$250.00 per semester.

To be eligible for the Dr. Myles and Ruth Munroe Scholarship, candidates must:

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have served in a ministry, participated in an extracurricular activity, or done community service within the past year at the time of application (as confirmed by the scholarship committee)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be matriculated in a postsecondary institution as a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior or at a technical school
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have a cumulative GPA of at least a 2.5 (confirmed by official college transcript, which should include final Spring 2021 grades)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submit a letter of recommendation (**Note: non-parent or immediate family member; other than Bishop John or Pastor Isha Edmondson)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submit a 500-word essay
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be less than 24 years of age

Submission Review & Notification

- **Applications are due on or before Sunday, June 13, 2021 (no exceptions)**
- **Applicants are encouraged to complete his/her application on their own unless they have a disability.**
- The **Dr. Myles & Ruth Munroe Scholarship** recipient will receive an award of \$500 **to be used within one year** of being awarded. The scholarship will be disbursed in two separate payments of \$250.00 per semester. Certification of continued enrollment will be required for the disbursement of the second \$250.00 payment.
- The scholarship will be payable directly to their school, with all monies going directly towards the costs of books, tuition, and school-related expenses.

Submissions will be reviewed by a committee of partners and leaders at Victory in Christ Christian Center. Selected applicants will be contacted for an online interview with the review committee.

Notification of the scholarship recipient will be made by phone or email before **College Sunday, August 15, 2021**. Awardees should be present in service on that date to be acknowledged by the Victory in Christ family.
