Specific Questions: 1Peter 4:1-9

1. At what age did you trust in Christ? Did your conversion serve as a relief from the carnal life Peter describes, or as a barrier to it?
2. In what areas of your employment, school, or other associations, are you expected to or tempted to violate God's moral standards? How do you handle or manage that? What responses do you receive from others?
3. In what ways do you "arm yourself" for the purpose of living according to God's will?
4. Have someone in the group read Col. 2:20-23 and Rev. 12:10. How do you balance these statements with 1Pet. 3:21? (legalism, Satan's accusations, and a clear conscience).
5. How frequently does the reality of God's judgement come into your thinking? How does it shape your life?
