NEW MEMBER CELEBRATION

LEADER: *My friends, today is a special day because today we welcome new members and their families at Grace Sacramento. I'd like to invite the following friends to join me in the front (New Members: Chris Chu, David Gae, Jeanne Gae, Lynn Reiswig, Charlene Shon, Karen Yoon, Sarah Lee; Transferring Members: Stephen Wagner-Davis, Mary Wagner-Davis, Emily Wagner-Davis, Joseph Wagner-Davis). Each of these before you have made a profession of faith, been baptized and welcomed to the Lord's Table by the elders of this church. As of today, they are entitled to all the rights and privileges of members of this church and their children as covenant children.*

Let's profess our faith and commitment together. First several questions to our new members, then several for the congregation,

LEADER: Beloved of God, I ask you before God and Christ's church to reject evil, to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, and to confess the faith of the church. Do you renounce sin and the power of evil in your life and in the world?

NEW MEMBERS: I renounce them.

LEADER: Who is your Lord and Savior?

NEW MEMBERS: Jesus Christ is my Lord and Savior.

LEADER: Will you be a faithful member of this congregation and, through worship and service, seek to advance God's purposes here and throughout the world?

CONGREGATIONAL CHARGE

LEADER: Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.

MEMBERS: Let each of us look not only to our own interests, but also to the interests of others.

LEADER: Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus

ALL: Who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

LEADER: Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name,

ALL : So that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Amen.
