CALL TO CONFESSION

The more we consider the 10,000 reasons to bless God for His greatness and perfection, we become more aware of our own sin and shortcomings. Our loving Father calls us to admit our sin and receive the forgiveness and healing that come through the work of the Son and the Spirit.

In a moment, we will join together in a confession, admitting to God what is wrong in our lives and in ourselves. Let's begin with a few moments of silence to take stock of all that we owe to our God and Father:

*Join me in confession by responding with "**Forgive us, Lord**"*

You have been good to us, but we have not loved You with our whole heart.

Forgive us, Lord.

You call us to return to You, but we fail to listen.

Forgive us, Lord.

You offer us life, but we hunger after that which does not satisfy.

Forgive us, Lord.

You want us to share the Good News about Jesus, but we remain silent.

Forgive us, Lord.

You command us to show mercy, but we walk away from people in need.

Forgive us, Lord.

You teach us what is right, but we tolerate injustice and sin.

Forgive us, Lord.

ASSURANCE

Be assured that you are forgiven by these words from 1 John:

But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous ... If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
