10:46a **Confession/Assurance**

*This part of our service, the call to confession of sin, is an integral part of worship. To come into the presence of the Holy One is to be made aware of our own sinfulness. It is both a recognition of our guilt before God and our awareness of the presence of and holiness of God, a sense of the ultimate worth of God accompanied by an overwhelming sense of our own unworthiness.*

*Our call to confession this morning comes from Isaiah 6. Let's take a look at the response of Isaiah the prophet when he is confronted with the majesty of God.*

**Confession of Sin** (Isaiah 6:1-5)

[1] In the year that King Uzziah died I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and the train of His robe filled the temple. [2] Above Him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. [3] And one called to another and said:

“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts;  
the whole earth is full of His glory!”

[4] And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke. [5] And I said: “Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!”

**Holy and gracious God,**

**Our Judge and Redeemer, we confess that we have tried to hide from You, for we have done wrong. We have lived for ourselves, and turned from our neighbors. We have refused to bear the troubles of others. We have ignored the pain of the world, and passed by the hungry, the poor, and the oppressed. O God, in Your great mercy forgive our sin and free us from selfishness, that we may choose Your will and obey Your commandments; through Jesus Christ our Savior. Amen.**
